An extremely enjoyable read which affected me quite dramatically. Most of this book is seen through the eyes of Validus, the last created Angel and gives greater insight into book one, The Cloak of Light. You'll see glimpses into this Angels past where you're taken beyond the ordinary as you travel inter-dimensionally, in a timeline of experiences before Creation to current time. Book one and two are perfectly pulled together toward the end, where after your discovery, you'll want to purchase the last book! While being fun and exceptional reading, I also found this book inspiring, challenging and impacting. There are characters and situations described here which stirred a craving in me to abandon mediocrity, and carelessness. To live life to the full and completely surrendered. The second in Chuck Black's War of the Realms trilogy, Rise of the Fallen, was nothing short of page turning, encompassing, and amazing. Book one, Cloak of Light, set the stage and was good in its own way, but where it left questions and sadness (plot wise) Rise of the Fallen brought fulfillment and excitement. Black painted beautiful scenes of Heaven pre-Earth creation and the lives of angels, thrilling images and emotional pictures of how it might have been to have lived in Heaven during the fall. And the feelings that Black built into the angels at the betrayal of one of their own joining the Fallen was palpable. This spiritual world is built on scripture and a lot of supposition but Black was able to bring to is a feeling of realness and vividness that made it come to life. After receiving a free reviewer's copy of this from Monmouth publishing, there are two things that must be said: this is a book for all ages and is the best yet of the War of the Realms series. Go ahead, pick it up and become engrossed in the two realms.

Well, the second book of Wars of the Realm is long winded, just like its predecessor! Thankfully, in this case, it's not because Chuck Black is busy telling us of Drew's tragedies, but because he takes us back to the beginning of time, to retell the first book, Cloak of the Light, from the view of the "Invaders"...
