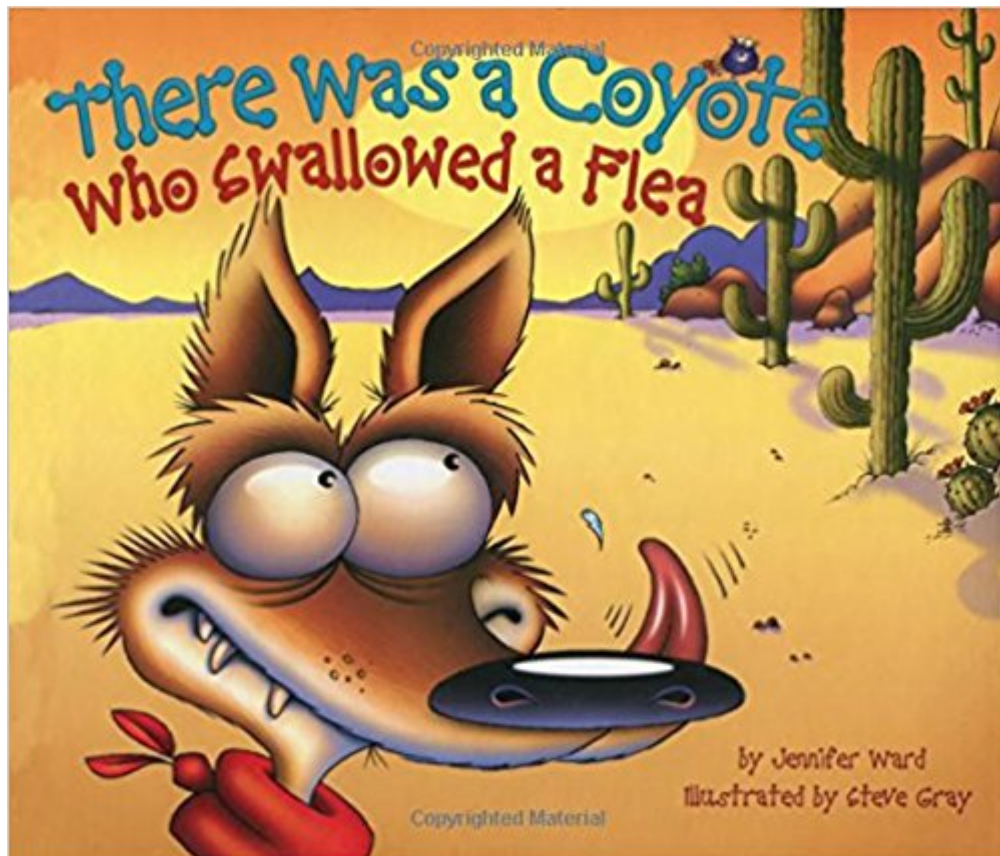

Jennifer Ward has done it to me again. *There Was a Coyote Who Swallowed a Flea*, and then

proceeded to eat everything in sight, across the desert and into the night sky. He ate and ate and ate some more, right up to the point you know he won't fit in another bite. What could this be leading up to? A funny little store in the middle of nowhere? A tourist trap on a really remote desert? A restaurant with a bizarre menu? No. No. And no. Just like *The Old Pirate Who Swallowed a Fish*, and the other Swallowed books of Ward's (*There was an Odd Princess*, *There Was an Old Mummy*, *There was an Old Martian*) it leads to nothing. More specifically it leaves the reader feeling like the last page is missing. As usual, the illustrations by Steve Gray are amazing and the saving grace of an otherwise unsatisfying book. My 4 yr old grandson thought *There Was an Old Pirate* was beyond funny, he actually calls it "The Funny Pirate" book. He is visually handicapped and I think the large, colorful pictures that also tell the story help him a lot. There also seems to be some 4/5 year old humor that I miss completely. The rhymes and repetition are wonderful for pre and early readers. As long as the books make him happy I will buy them and I will continue to read them to him in my best sing-song voice. He hasn't received this one yet, I'll know shortly if this is a hit or miss. I don't like to recommend this book, because the ending is so weak. I'm sure that such a gifted writer could do so much better. But, if you have a silly four year old, pre k or kindergarten class you might want to try it. It is returnable through Prime. This book gets three stars for the illustrations.
