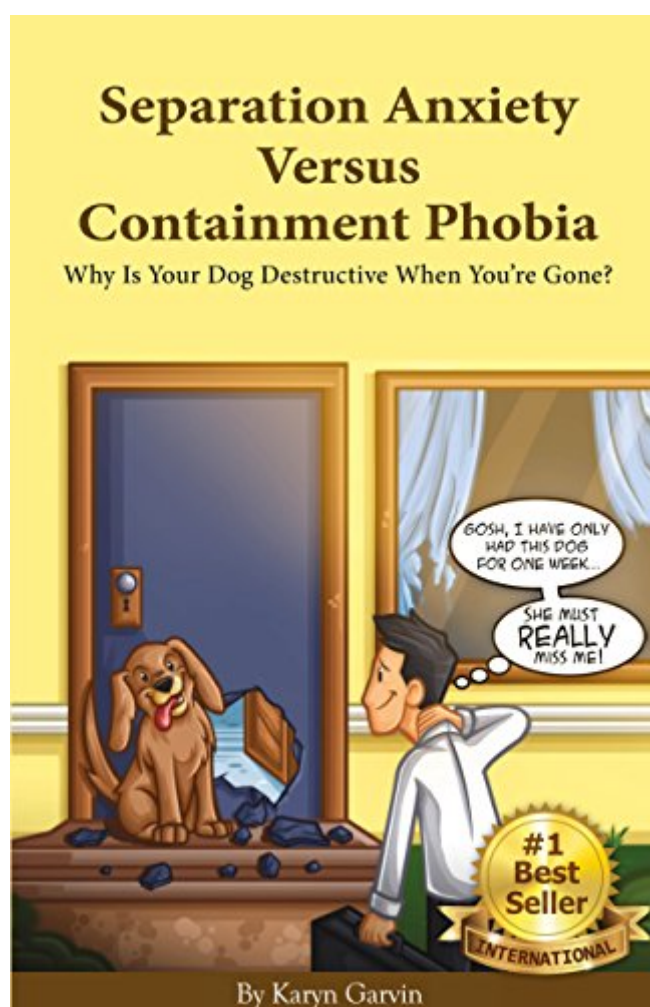

This book definitely helped me realize that my dog has containment phobia, not separation anxiety. I think it gives great examples to help you differentiate between the two. That being said, that is all I can say positive about this book. I found it to be very unfocused. I felt that there were random tangents in the middle of chapters to talk about specific researchers and trainers or to give owner testimonials. They didn't seem to belong in the places they were located and they distracted from the flow and point of the chapters. I'm not a dog trainer, but I do work closely with an animal rescue and fostering organization. I found that a lot of the suggestions in the book were "bandaids" rather than solutions and remedies to dog issues. For example, if your dog chews on things while you are away, a muzzle was suggested. Yes, a muzzle will solve the problem. However, it just prevents the dog from physically chewing, it doesn't modify the dog's behavior so that he/she doesn't have the need to chew any longer. I was hoping for more suggestions on how to condition my dog to be okay in her crate or okay with being left alone, not just small fixes so that my house isn't destroyed while her anxiety and fears are still present.
