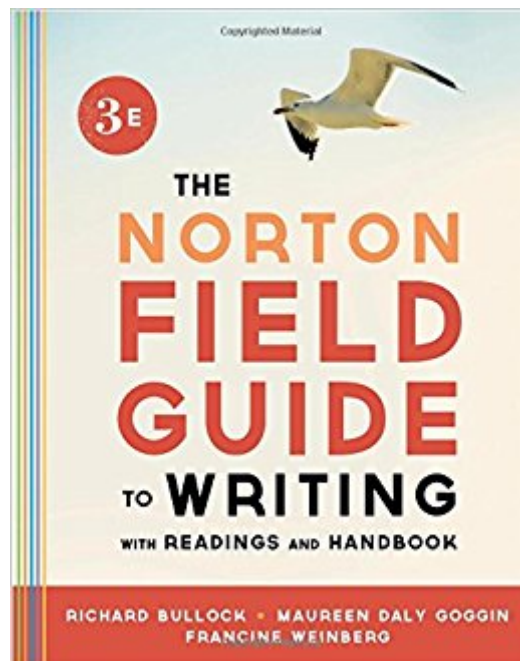




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The Norton Field Guide To Writing, With Readings And Handbook (Third Edition)

Francine Weinberg (M.Ed, Teachers College, Columbia University) is an author and editor who has worked for more than thirty years on college and high school English textbooks.
