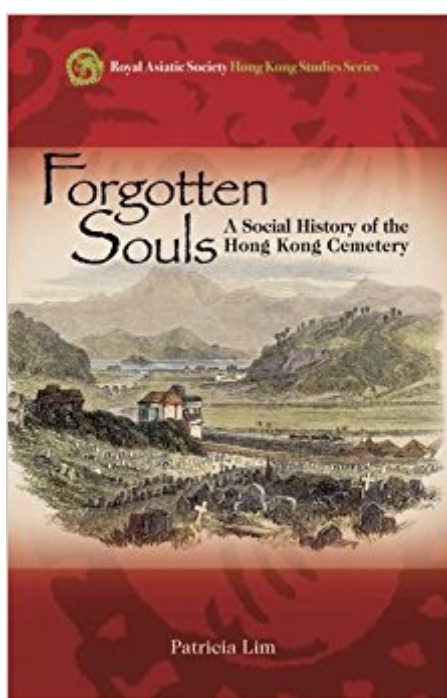

A most engaging book, involving lengthy research. Unfortunately some of the facts are of dubious veracity - possibly the author was overambitious in setting the scope of her study. However her industriousness is not to be disparaged and she writes well.

It is scholarly work that was on the expensive side. It is also a good history of a part of China but little character development, but interesting. Takes some time to work through it.

I am a history buff of all kinds and this book is packed with Hong Kong history and cultures. Good read.

I was most impressed by the quality of this fine, well written, well produced book which contains illustrations and photographs. It was recommended by a friend, and it didn't disappoint in any way - and I was happy to see an article about my father in it, including a poem that he had written while a prisoner of the Japanese during WW2.
