

"When God Is Silent" was a hidden gem among many spiritual books available to the modern reader. The theology of Jesus sleeping and the interpretation of that theology was life-changing for me. In all my years of hearing homilies (34+), I'd never realized that God was speaking through

Jesus' times of rest and sleep. Moreover, Archbishop Luis Martinez explores - in a rather mystical way - how Jesus sleeps in our hearts. I was profoundly changed by this book. It is a short, but certainly not easy, read, for I could only take a few paragraphs per day in order to fully digest each segment's meaning. All of us have experienced some sort of desert moments in our interior lives, but Martinez illuminates the grander purpose of God's seeming absence, which is really a deeper infusion of His presence, within us. "When God Is Silent" enlightened my understanding about holy darkness, a spiritual treatise I first discovered through St. John of the Cross. I realized that the moments when God seems to have withdrawn Himself from my life and has quieted the embers of zeal are moments of pruning, prayerful waiting, and cultivation of virtue that are necessary. Perhaps the next phase of life will be spiritually active, but Martinez reminds us to allow Jesus to sleep in our hearts and to provide Him a tranquil resting place for as long as He needs. In essence, this defines the depth of our love for Him when we offer Him an abode to sleep and do not receive anything from Him, but rather give of ourselves to Him instead. I would say this is not a book for the spiritual novice. It is very conducive to contemplation and interior reflection. A must-have for those who are changed by spiritual classics.
