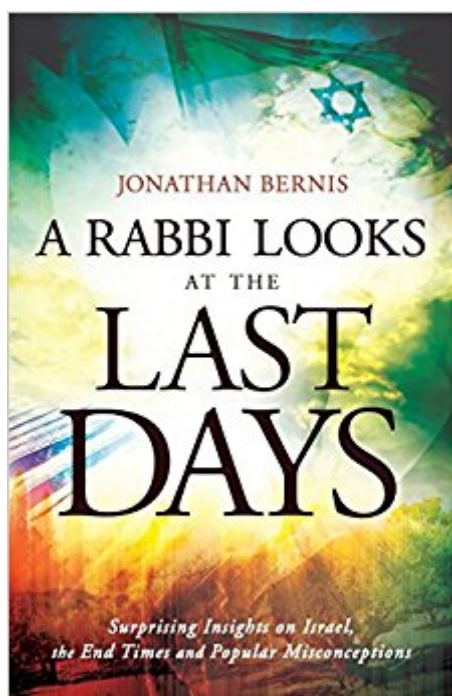

It is time for Scriptural references to lead back to the Last Days, the times of God's Wrath. How appropriate that a Rabbi highlight these 6 markers! It is sure to strengthen your foundation in the Word. Who has time for this short book? Hopefully, those who want more ammunition to face overwhelming deceptions.
