

This sequel to The Fate of Perfection was advertised as Ryker and Millicent defending their new home on the planet Paradise from the conglomerates, especially Moxodine, on Earth coming after them and their daughter Marie. It actually turns into a preemptive operation back on Earth to destroy once and for all the power of the conglomerates. Of course, as soon as they return to Earth, there is constant action as the preeminent conglomerate, Toxon, pulls out all stops to capture them, especially Millicent and Marie. It seems Toxon has developed a way to use human brains as the main processing units in their super computers, and Millicent and Marie, because of their superior intelligence, would make the most powerful computers of all. The story devolves into a running battle between our heroes from Paradise against the robot defenses of Toxon. Along the way, they find and rescue Millicent's sister and another group of children with super superior intelligence. While there is plenty of constant action, I found the set up to be a bit illogical. Why would Ryker and Millicent risk going back to Earth, with their daughter, with no imminent threat to their new home, especially after their narrow escape from Earth, knowing there is a vicious war going on? Planning and preparing an in depth defense of Paradise would make a lot more sense. While I found fault with the set up of the story, I would recommend it for anyone who likes constant action and wants to follow up on the first story of the series.

I don't give 5 stars very easily. It has to be good enough to make me want to stop strangers on the street to tell them they have to read this book. This book, along with "Fate of Perfection", meets that requirement. I will definitely keep my eye out for more from this author. It is also refreshing to read an ebook that has been properly edited. It's rare that I read a book and don't find multiple errors.

I'm not very good at reviewing books. The second book in this series left me disappointed with the development of the characters and the ambiguities of the storyline. It's a little far-fetched of an idea to decide to "conquer" a planet with a handful of rebels, clones and children. While I enjoyed the action I felt unfulfilled by the limited explanation of events, abilities of the characters and tidy outcome. Not sure I'll pick up the third book if one becomes available.

Another great story to add to the Fate series! This book picked up where book 1 left off, and Breene did not hesitate to drop us back into the action and intrigue. I loved the plot, characters, and the ability to draw you into the story. I couldn't put the book down once I started it, so it only took me one day to read it. I am recommending this series to all my friends!!

The story lines in this book 2 take an interesting twist from world saving to alien warfare. Battles, relentless gore and warfare all of which keep the story moving but become boring near the end. Character development is weaker in this book than in book 1, and the story line changes are somewhat clumsy. Nevertheless, if you want to disconnect yourself from reality for a while it's a good read. But read book 1 first to understand the back story.

After I read the first book, I pre-ordered this one, counting the days until I could read it. When it ended, I wanted another one with the same characters. Will we get a third one in this series? I loved it, it showed a dark future for this planet, but it was not a dark book, it was fast, alert, funny and engaging. The first book was about Millie and Ryker, this one was about all of them. Now it would be nice to see Danissa and Dagger, that should be fun to read.
