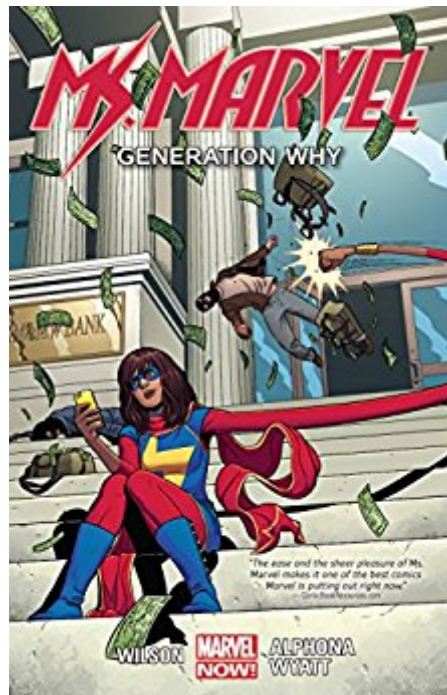




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Ms. Marvel Vol. 2: Generation Why (Ms. Marvel Series)

Wilson takes Marvel Comics back to the wonderful, core basics that won them millions of fans worldwide--a teenage girl who feels like a social outsider gains fantastic powers that she tries to use for good, even as it overcomplicates her personal life. Teaming up with Wolverine while fighting an evil genius parakeet is just frosting on the cake.
