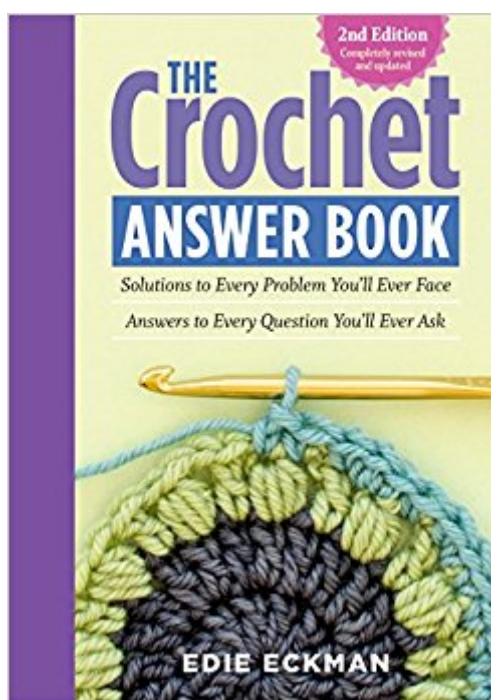

She is a nationally known teacher, designer, writer, and editor in both the crochet and knitting worlds. She lives in Waynesboro, Virginia.

This is a wonderful resource tool for everyone from the beginner to the advanced crocheter. I have many of Ms. Edie Eckman's crochet books and find that, without exception, they are extremely well-written and the designs are top notch. I also own the first edition of this title. That book is about ten years old and I have used it all the time. I was provided a temporary digital advance reader copy of the new edition (by the publisher via Netgalley). Once I had gone through it, I knew that I would (and did) pre-order the hard copy to have on hand at all times. There was enough update to the book - new yarns and techniques - that getting the second edition made complete sense. I honestly have not had a crochet question come up which is not addressed in this answer book. The illustrations are not great but the information is definitely sufficient to work through my issues. This is not a pattern book; it is a resource book to find answers to issues you never even knew that you had. While reading through it, I had many "Aha!" moments when I realized that I had been doing something in a less than optimal way. Whether for yourself or as a gift for someone you know who crochets, this book is a perfect addition to the crocheters bookcase. Though that is a misstatement - it will never sit in my bookcase, it will stay in my bag with my latest project so that it is never more than an arm's reach away from me. I cannot recommend this book highly enough.

I bought this for my wife who, recently retired, is just learning to crochet. She loves it! She is enjoying the learning of this new skill and has appreciated the help she has gotten from this great little book. This book has literally kept her in stitches.

I am just learning how to crochet...and I have many questions...if you can't find the answer in this book, there is no answer! It is very well written and organized....I bought both the hard copy and the PDF version to read on my kindle app. I definitely recommend anyone who is just learning, or just to cross checkthe only complaint I have is the print in the paper version is too small, esp for us oldtimers.

Provided a wealth of information and tips for every person who crochets. Just starting out or have been doing it for awhile, I would recommend keeping it on hand. I toss it in my yarn bag to keep handy. The smaller size makes it just right to keep on hand without taking up too much space.
