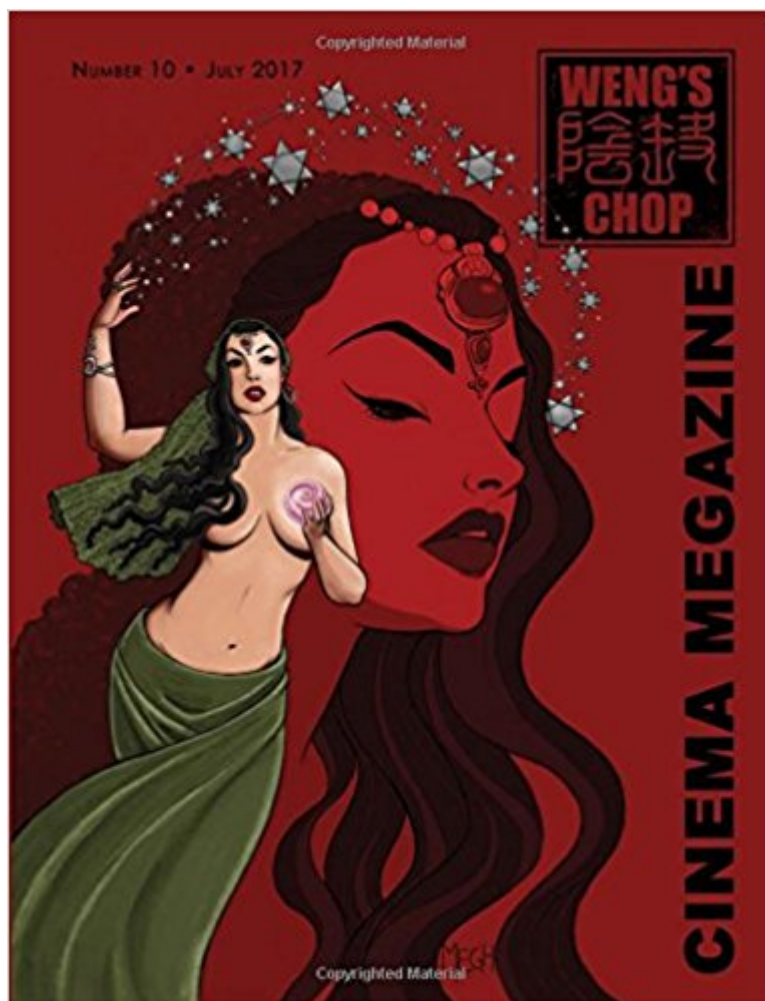

Some of my favorite sections are Tim Paxton's "50 Years of Indian Ghostly Possession Cinema, Part 2", which runs an amazing 35 pages!; Louis Paul's "The Films Of Andy Sidaris, complete with reviews of all his films; My guiltiest pleasure has to be the Christmas telefilms that play on Lifetime, The Hallmark Channel and ION every holiday season. (Genre filmmaker David Decoteau directed a couple to be shown this year on Lifetime!) by author Casey Bohn. Other articles include a chronological review of all the Godzilla films; a dissertation on the film THE SAILOR WHO FELL FROM GRACE WITH THE SEA; The cut-and-paste films of Godfrey Ho; Video games turned into films; Greek VHS tapes; Trashy Turkish films; an obituary and interview with H.G. Lewis, the Godfather of Gore; an interview with Jeff Lieberman and reviews of two of his films: BLUE SUNSHINE and one of my personal favorites, SQUIRM; another interview with art film director Damon Packard; Reviews of films shown at the Korean Fantasy Film Festival (There are films here for every taste); And more reviews than you can shake a stick at.
