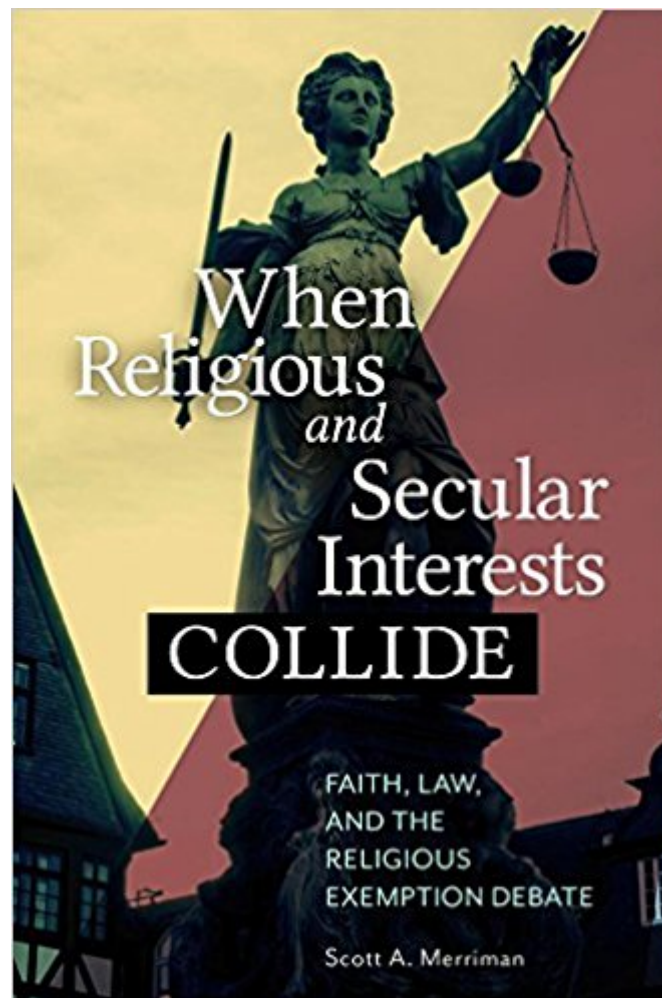




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When Religious And Secular Interests Collide: Faith, Law, And The Religious Exemption Debate
