

This book had some good information. Lots of pictures and very readable. Still missed a lot of codes and info. If you are only going to get one code book, do yourself a favor and get "Code Check Complete". It has all the codes in a very readable checklist type format separated by sections. It includes foundations, framing, electrical, plumbing, and HVAC. Basically anything you would need to know in order to build to code. It has helped me tremendously with my bathroom renovation.

Awesome BOOK!!! HIGHLY recommend to anyone doing projects around the house. It pays (especially nowadays) to be educated on this stuff--you don't want to go into your home sale with code issues that you could have avoided when you did the work in the first place. VERY costly sometimes!!! Great descriptions with just the right amount of layman's terms and professional lingo, along with GREAT illustrations/pictures to communicate very effectively the topic. HIGHLY recommend this!!

If you've ever read the IBC then you know how confusing it can be. This book is for the novice builder or home remodeler. It is full of information that is easy to understand. I recommend this for anyone who is doing a project and needs a permit from the local authorities. I would have given it 5 stars, but some of the information didn't have enough details for me.

Caution!! This book is just a very basic, simple reference. It's the equivalent to a Haynes manual for

a vehicle compared to the actual shop manual. It has sporadic information and is a lot like playing the lottery.... It may or may not have what you're looking for and if it does have it, it seems to leave out the punch line. I personally would not recommend getting this unless you need some office reading material. If anyone knows of an actual book that is more informative please let me know some how.

I learned many new things about the code and keeping my house safe in this book. It also has useful descriptions and tables for things like notching studs and joists which were a hassle for me to find elsewhere. The sections on common mistakes were also helpful. While I am an experienced do it yourselfer I found important things in that section as well.

This book is very light on the amount of information it gives. The information is accurate. I was expecting slightly more from this book. If I were able to glance through the whole book I would have gotten something else.

This is a great overall look at the most common code issues and can be a huge time saver. There is no way to be completely comprehensive on all structural, plumbing and electrical codes in one book. If you want more detail on a specific issue go look into the codes themselves. This book is a great place to start. Also definitely get the paperback version, the printing and paper is very high quality.

Not a bad book, it has a lot of general info in it. For less than 20 bucks its nice to have as a reference for projects.
