

This is what a biography should be: a well-researched, well-written examination of where a person comes from and what makes his or her life worth examining. Evel Knievel was a bona fide superhero to me and my generation as we were growing up, but we didn't know the whole story. Montville expertly tells the rise and fall of self-made man Robert Craig Knievel, the moral of which is this: admire Evel's achievements but don't admire the man.

Parts were interesting but not a page turner.

This is the third book on Evel that I read and my favorite. I grew up watching Evel on Wide World Of Sports, played with the toys, rode my bike then motorcycle, stood on seat and did wheelies. Can't help but love him and hate him at the same time. Very interesting life he made for himself. How does one man out of billions in the world become a household name. I recommend this to anyone interested in that question.

This is a surprisingly well presented tale about one of Butte's strange people. Leigh Montville has fashioned a really interesting tale about the life of Knievel. Little seems to have been invented to make the book such a good read. I recognize the 50's, 60's in Butte and only just discovered the rest of Evel's adventures in the wider world. I enjoyed this presentation and was surprised to learn that I did. A friend mentioned one name in this book, moments later had found the book and loaded it to my Kindle. It is a good read!

Really liked the way this book was written. It did not spend too much time with childhood and great grandfathers as other Bio's tend to do just to take up 20 extra pages. For me it was a non stop ride of evel's lust for life. I do wish it would have gone just little more in to the remaining years of his life but I guess there was'nt much there to tell.

Great effort from longtime sportswriting star Montville here. I found myself marveling time and again
