

Kurt Schmidt has almost 18 years of successful experience in a fee-paid executive search and recruiting. Currently, he is the president and owner of a specialized search firm focused on filling Supply Chain Management positions in Fortune 500 energy and manufacturing companies.

I had the opportunity to work with Kurt personally over the years, most recently for a Director level position in a Fortune 500 company. Working with Kurt was always insightful, and through his teacher/mentor approach I not only was successful in finding a leadership position but also learned a great deal about the process. I was naturally excited to learn he has now written a book on the subject. I was looking for a book on interview preparation and found Kurt's book "Modern Job Search" unique to others on the market. Rather than a laundry list of categorized question/answers, the book approaches the subject from a process perspective. The book follows three individuals at various levels of their career, from start to finish in the interview process. The scenarios reinforce the fundamental process from start to finish common at all levels, from preparation to follow-up. But it also highlights the dynamics that differ, for example if you are looking for a leadership position vs. an entry level job. Regarding standard interview preparation, rather than a laundry list of canned questions, Kurt laid out an incredible format to how you frame your answers so they are concise, demonstrative of results, and most importantly framed in a way to get feedback. A simple concept he demonstrates is how to follow up each answer with a question to get feedback. I was initially uncomfortable with this approach, but it worked incredibly well!! When I followed this approach, I found I changed from an interview (me doing all the talking) to a collaborative discussion. If you are

back into the job search or interviewing for higher level positions and need to improve your interview skills, this book is a must!

Its common sense; finding that first job, advancing your career or changing career paths requires the same understanding. Know yourself and what you want, understand your value, and identify employers who need what you are offering. Unfortunately these simple truths are so often obscured in the modern world. Schmidt, a professional recruiter with years of experience matching job seekers and employers, reminds us that finding a good position (and hiring the right employee) is about finding good matches. Narrating the trajectories of three seemingly very different job searches Schmidt shares these insights and provides useful tools and advice for anyone seeking employment as a professional in today's competitive markets.

I really enjoyed reading "Modern Job Search: Insider Knowledge and Strategies that Work". The author definitely delivers what the title promises.
