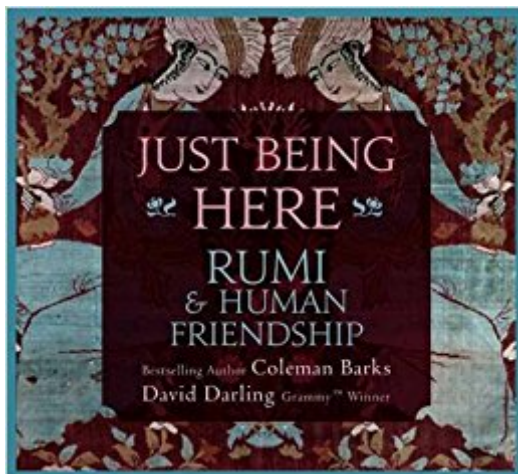

Coleman Barks was born on April 23, 1937, in Chattanooga, Tennessee. He graduated from the University of North Carolina and the University of California at Berkeley. Since 1972 he has taught English at the University of Georgia at Athens. Barks received the New England/Breadloaf Quarterly Narrative Poem Prize and the Southern Poetry Review's Guy Owen Award. His collections of poetry include *The Juice and Gourd Seed*. Barks is perhaps better known as a translator of the poet Rumi, a thirteenth century Mystic. Rumi is considered the greatest mystic of the Sufi religion and wrote extensively in Farsi, the language of Iran.

Again, can't go wrong with a Coleman Barks rendition of Rumi. This is particularly lovely Another exceptional body of work by Coleman Barks. The fact that there are 3 CD's also makes this an especially good value. Of course, the addition of music by the wonderful David Darling only further

enhances the experience of this set which provides nearly 2hrs 40 minutes of listening pleasure. I would highly recommend it to anyone who is a fan of Rumi's work and Barks' translations and readings.
