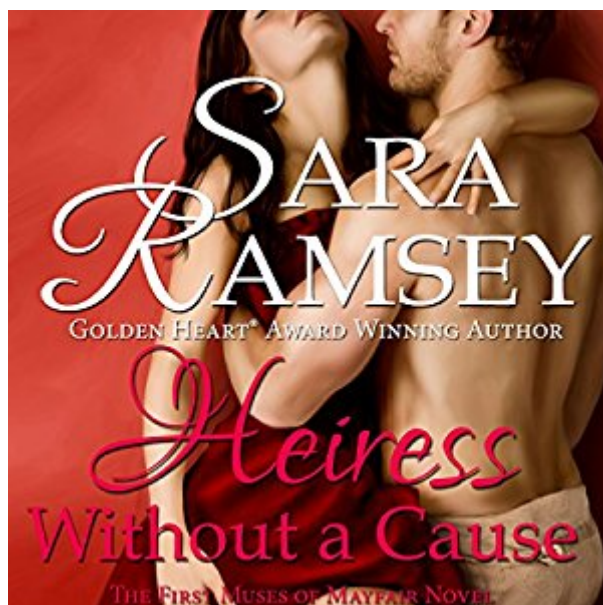


The book was found

Ms Ramsey says she loves her main characters, Madeleine and Ferguson, and I share her affection. They and their side characters make this novel a true pleasure to read. And, to be honest, the pleasure is more than a little erotic. Ms Ramsey's imagination and originality are top of class and

her story line is among the most unique I've found in this genre. I might add, however, I normally subscribe to the "show not tell" ideal, but the descriptions of her characters' thinking, while a trifle verbose, are so believable I found them as intriguing and attention-holding as the dialogue and action.

This was a fun story with some steamy scenes. I thought it was a unique idea having Lady Madeleine exploring her dream of acting as Hamlet. The only thing that was a little strange was how it randomly switched from his perspective to hers almost mid thought. Overall it was enjoyable and I'm definitely interested in the rest of the Muses of Mayfair series.

A very good historical romance. Spinster at the advanced age of 28 in England means that Madeline is not fit for the marriage mart. She secretly wants the life of an actress and takes a part on a stage in an unsavory part of London. She takes into her confidence her 1st cousin Amelia and her very dear friend Prudence. She is found out by Ferguson a reported rake who has returned from Scotland where he has been in self imposed exile for 10 years. The story unfolds from this point.

Was easy to care about the characters. Lots of fun and minimal insufferable arrogance that's so common in this era of romance. A bit of the the love at first sight trope but not bad or particularly distracting. Good side characters I'm looking forward to reading about later.
