

Mr. Norcross has a wonderful way with words, capturing the facts and the emotion without

Most of us who lived through the hell of Hurricane Andrew in the Redland area of Homestead needed a calm, reassuring voice as we scrambled from one room to another with our homes flying apart around us. Bryan was that voice - first on television, then on radio - that explained what was happening and how to stay alive. While this book certainly reopened wounds from the storm and aftermath, it is required reading for anyone living in coastal areas. The takeaway from this book should be to be prepared and do not take warnings lightly. We were prepared for a hurricane, but we were not prepared for Andrew. All the supplies in the world are meaningless when they are sucked out of the house. Although it has been 25 years since Andrew, many of us still pace the floor when we are awakened by wind and rain at night. My family and I were thankful that Bryan warned us of the possibility of taking a direct hit while others brushed the storm off as just another close call.

This is another high quality educational book by the man who got a lot of very frightened folks through the category 5 monster that laid waste to Dade County, FL on August 24, 1992 (and tore up Louisiana a few days later).
