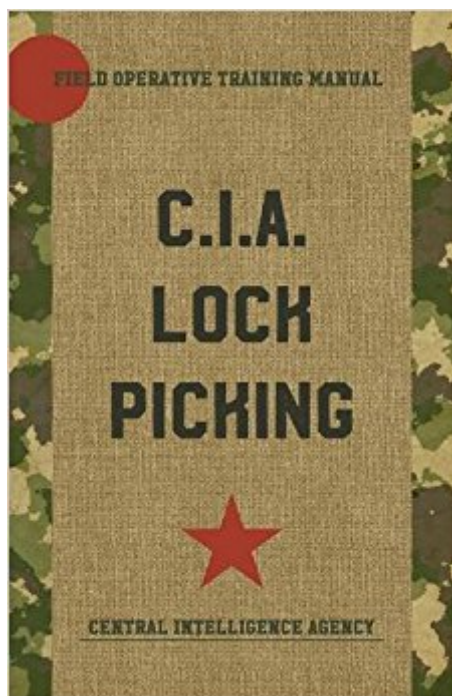

Reading this book is certainly enough to get you started picking simple locks, but remember: a great deal of time and patience are needed to become a truly proficient locksmith. In this volume, you will learn the fundamental theories of lock picking in addition to proper terminology, the importance of tool design (i.e. how to select and use the right tool for a given job), the effects of tolerances, and finally the techniques most commonly used by locksmiths to successfully pick the vast majority of standard pin and wafer tumbler locks. Lock picking is a useful, engaging, and satisfying skill; with this book and a little determination, you'll be off to a great start.

The title of this "book" is very misleading. It is actually a pithy pamphlet that took me approximately 15 minutes to read, and gave me little to no information beyond what I already know as a thinking person. It is short, poor, and the only thing "CIA" about it is the the letters in the title. If anything, this book could serve as the first chapter in a much longer and more thorough lock picking manual, as in that capacity it might be construed as useful. I rarely (if ever) give one star, but this is definitely the pits, and (I believe) intentionally titled to mislead buyers and drive sales.

I have four stars, because.....Yes most, if not all, information in this book can be found online for free. If you're like me, and a bit old school, this book for under 10\$ is good. It's a quick start into lock picking, which I believe is the intent of the book. It's very basic, but does provide a good foundation on which to build your skills. My job requirements are such that we may have to gain entry to places when a key has been misplaced, lost, or stolen....So to be able to have that access without causing damage to property is a benefit. As basic as this book is....It covers all the material I'll ever need to do my job more efficiently.

In my opinion, this is an excellent book for beginners and anyone new to the concept of how pin tumbler locks work. It's thorough with plenty of depth and examples.
