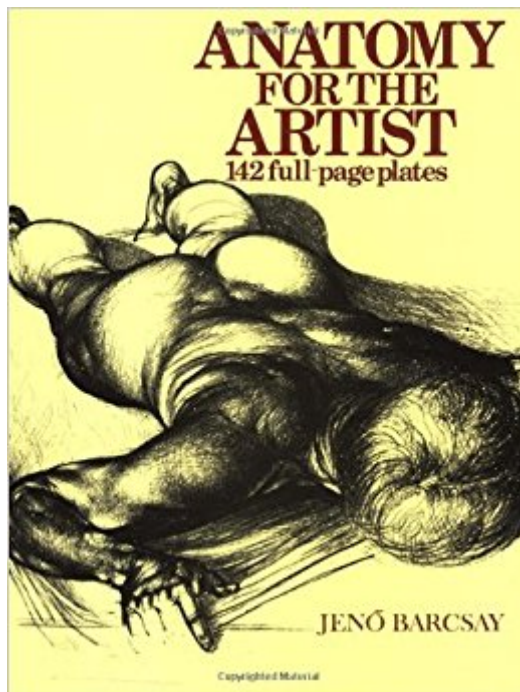

I was going to give the book 3 stars BUT I blame myself for my dissatisfaction. The book itself is quite nice and I have no complaints at all with the text or illustrations per say. It's just the book is smaller than I anticipated..I should have checked the dimensions of the book (which is 8.5 x 7.1 x 1.2 inches). I also feel that in some cases, there are too many pictures on one page (leading to more "size issues").I wanted a book from which I could draw copies of the anatomical illustrations. This book doesn't work for me in that manner.Having said all that, the info and the pictures are lovely. I just wish it were a larger book with larger pictures (7.5 by 11 would be perfect but this is just my opinion).
