

With minimal work an intermediate level guitarist can play these and even come up with better arrangements on their own if so determined. It is a nice compilation and easy to embellish which is necessary as most of the tunes would get very boring if played with all the repeats. For beginner and intermediate level, it is a great buy and well worth it, and assuming that this is the target audience I must give the book 5 stars even though it is a little boring for me. It has come in handy for a few gigs.

The Hal Leonard Corporation seems to think the only alternate tuning for a guitar is Drop D (DADGBE). When I purchased this book I was hoping to find songs for DADGAD tuning. No luck. I play solo guitar instrumentals during communion at our church so these songs will definitely help. The tablature is essential as I don't read musical notation when I play guitar. Also, I prefer books that have accompanying CDs, like the book "A DADGAD Christmas" by Doug Young. I wish all musical books were as comprehensive as this. This book has no CD. It's not a showstopper by any means. Just not as enjoyable.

I bought this for Kindle. The staff is minuscule and you can't zoom in (I've tried on my Kindle, computer, tablet, and phone). I must say I'm disappointed.
