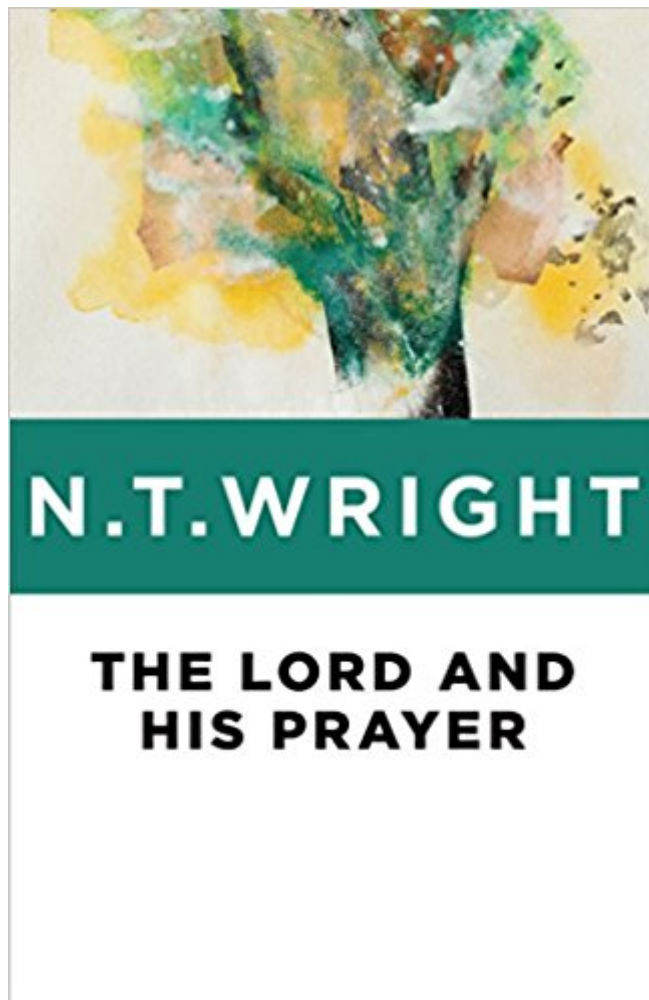

This is Wright at his most lay-person friendly form. I've used this twice for Lenten study groups and it never fails to stretch people. The chapters are somewhat uneven, ranging from brilliant (chapter four) to very hard to follow (chapter three). If you're looking for a good general introduction to Wright for lay people, this is a great book to use.

As Jesus taught His disciples - and we must never forget WE are also His disciples, so we must continue to pray "without ceasing." For those who were brought up in, or adopted, a tradition of saying the prayer frequently, the danger becomes that the prayer becomes rote, just something we say... N.T. Wright helps us explain why it is much more than that, that there is much more meaning than meets the eye. His explanation is theologically sound, but is written for those of us who are not theologians. I recommend this book highly and encourage us to stop and think about it when we say the Lord's Prayer, the things Jesus commands us to be thankful, praiseful of, and grateful for.
