

The story moved in an effortlessly fluid manner. It always amazes me that in this world constructed entirely from imagination I'm never left feeling lost as a reader. There are no holes in Marie's flawless writing.Piper's tale is full of action and suspense, but also bursting with emotional turmoil - both good and bad. As with the rest of this series, Reap the Shadows is captivating. Awe inspiring descriptions make you feel like you are stepping into the daemon worlds.Once again I was sucked in from the very beginning and hated anything that forced me to put the book down. Piper is a fantastic main character who has plenty to stress about but never comes off as whiny as some heroine's do.The characters' relationships are not storybook perfect, which makes them fantastically realistic. I did not want the book to end and it is torture to know I will have to wait for book 5.This entire series is a definite must read.

My favorite book in the series thus far! WARNING: If you haven't read the first three books my review will be slightly spoiler-ish.Book four picks up 10 days after the last book. Ash is still in the Overwold recovering from his wounds. Piper is still searching for Lyre and Seiya with no luck. She is in hiding with her father and the other outcast Consuls. She's still adjusting to her newfound magic

and is trying to stop thinking about Ash. Once again, another pulse pounding story. So addicting! The next and final book will not be released for four weeks! The waiting is AGONY! The good news is that this book doesn't leave the story on the edge of a cliff hanger. It's a satisfying ending leading to our final book which I hope wraps up our beloved characters story. There is a novella 3.5 Feed the Flames that I skipped in favor of devouring this story as quickly as possible. I don't feel like I really missed anything pertinent to the series but I have a feeling it gives insight to Lyre and Seiya's characters. I plan to go back and read it.

It has been a great journey so far. I have been reading day and night coz I fell in love with the slow build of characters and anticipation. Piper is such a smart and intelligent girl unlike so many other heroines, she processes everything fast and makes decisions quickly. I have read so many books where the lead characters are shown super strong and powerful but emotionally so confused and half the books are filled with -"oh my god, what to do. I feel this. I don't feel this and blah..." I mostly just skip all that inner rant of emotions but in this book, she thinks, she analyses and she concludes. Damn, that's a fresh change.
