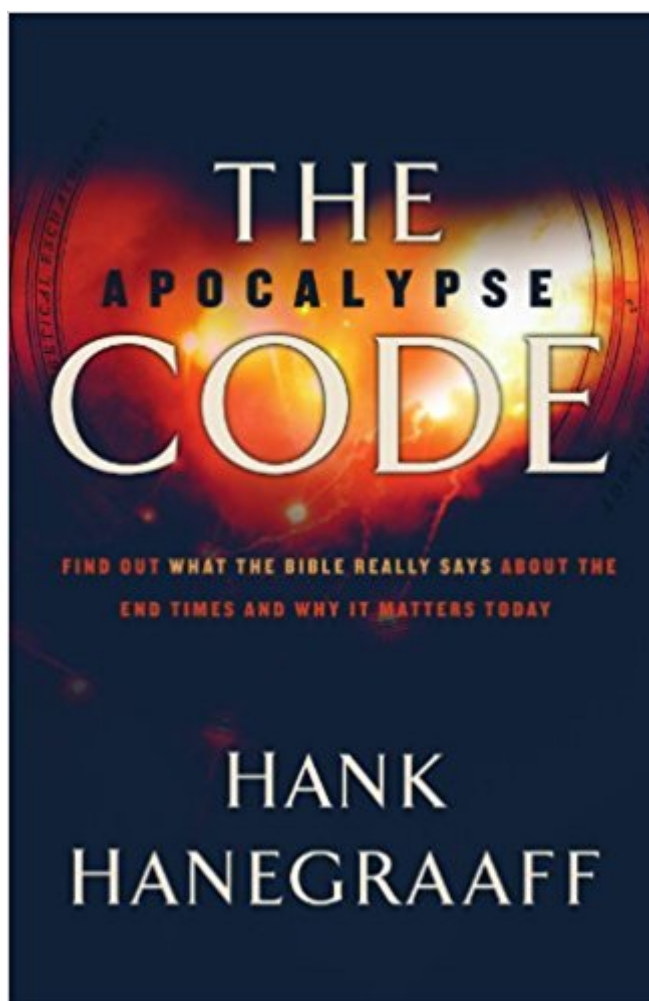


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The Apocalypse Code: Find Out What The Bible Really Says About The End Times And Why It Matters Today

Hanegraaff argues that the key to understanding the last book of the Bible is the other sixty-five books of the Bible – not current events or recent history and certainly not any complicated charts. The *Apocalypse Code* offers sane answers to some very controversial questions: What does it mean to take the book of Revelation (and the rest of the Bible) literally? Who are the “Antichrist” and the “Great Whore of Babylon,” and what is the real meaning of “666”? How does our view of the end times change the way we think about the crisis in the Middle East? Are two-thirds of all Jews really headed for an apocalyptic holocaust? A must have work to understand how to understand the typology and eschatology of the Bible. Hank does a great job of dispensing with a lot of the sensationalism and lack of context that often seems so dominate in the Pre-Millennialism groups of the Church. Placing the often used "proof-texts" back in to their historical context and proper place within the Biblical narrative goes a long way towards seeing many of the flaws with this viewpoint. Too many people of the "Rapture" viewpoint just dismiss dissenting interpretations off hand, without considering them. Even if you are one that holds to the teachings of Hagge and LeHaye, and their crowd, you owe it to yourself to hear some of the arguments that oppose your viewpoint and evaluate them on their merits, and this book would be very handy for that.

We've been to spoon fed ideas from popular books. This book shows the views of most of the early church up until 1800. The evidence is so overwhelming, there are sooo many scriptures in plain english, litterally that it finally makes sense now. This is coming from a 25 year belief in the modern dispensational thinking of pre mid post trib. The great thing about this book is it's simplicity and understandability, because many of the other end times books and teachers on Preterism are wacky.
