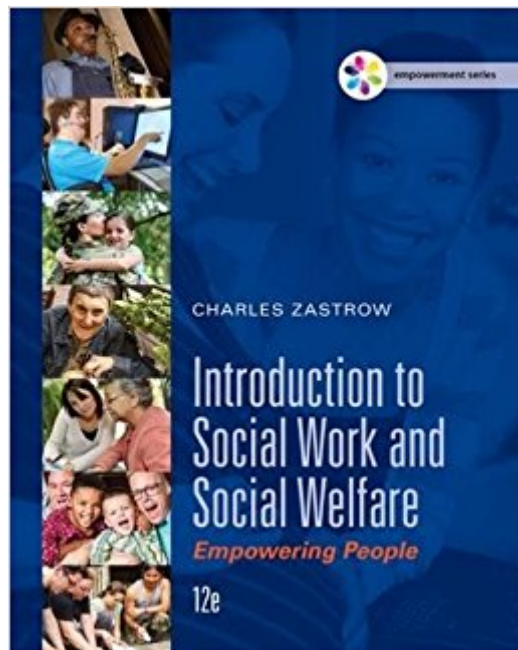


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Empowerment Series: Introduction To Social Work And Social Welfare: Empowering People
