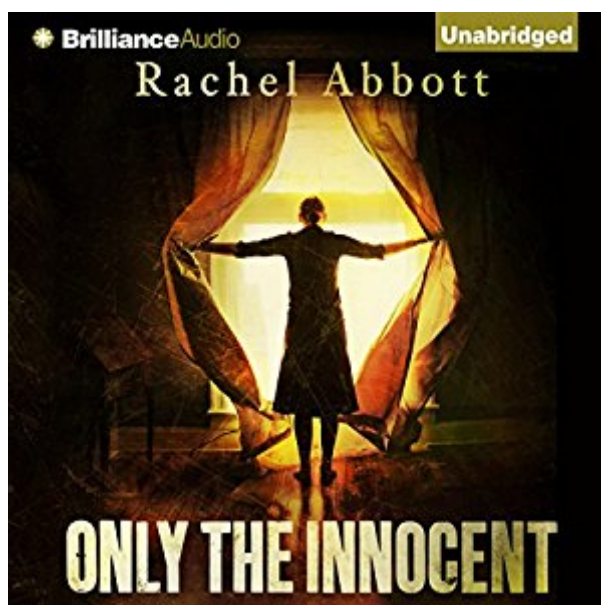


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Only The Innocent

Although it was a very abusive sick relationship between the two main characters, I did not find it offensive to read. In fact I found it to be a page turner. For me it was just enough detail without being raunchy. I would imagine it was hard for the author to make this balance in the sex scenes of the book. I usually skip over those but did not have to with this author. In fact, the sex scenes were set in intrigue instead of explicit detail. Although for some others, they may want more detail.

This book kept me guessing the entire time. I was even surprised by the end result. I wanted to know more and more the deeper I got into the plot. It was hard to put down.

When I noticed the text at the top of the book's cover ("Women are rarely cold blooded killers") I thought I might be bored. I figured it would be another one of those novels in which the male victim is a bit of a cad and one of the women he hurt has finally snapped. While this could be a broad description of the story, it doesn't come close to covering just how abhorrent the "victim" was. I was

simultaneously pleased that there was actually a villain in the story and revolted at his actions. I did find some parts a bit long and tedious and I admit I skipped forward a few pages when it got to those sections. They were necessary to the story in showing the villain's psychopathy and as a bit of a Red Herring, but they could have been covered with far fewer paragraphs. Otherwise, I would have given this five stars.

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
